- An OPE approach with creative and collaborative thinking about estates strategies and capital plans to address inequalities across key thematic areas of Housing, Education, Health and Regeneration


General Outputs across the Public Sector

- Better understanding between public sector organisations of their physical presence (estate & service)
- Greater understanding of local needs and opportunities, especially levels of inequality
- Establishment/enhancement of network between service providers
- Sharing of knowledge between public sector organisations
- Enabling of more integrated health and social care estate, focusing on areas with highest inequalities in health, education, and housing

- What project is anticipated to deliver (assessed against inequalities)
- 4 How project is to be developed/taken forward
- 5 Key dates/timescale for delivery
